ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

East end representatives and residents know that the best time to stop a proposal is before the final decision is made. On this front, NDP MPPS have been actively mobilizing the local east end community since this Spring to put the pressure on the McGuinty government to issue this regulation disallowing the Third Transmission line in the IPSP plan. In addition to raising this issue on a number of occasions in the legislature, media and different community meetings, MPP Peter Tabuns has been conducting a door canvass over the summer to collect signatures on petitions supporting such a regulation and reinvestment of focus and resources into efficiency, conservation, cogeneration and green power. The NDP Green Lights plan also sets the stage to make the possibility of the third transmission line obsolete. The Green Lights plan also brings additional good news for Toronto Danforth residents. The targets for efficiency, localized cogeneration and green power, and conservation under this plan sets the stage to Toronto communities from the possibility of a high voltage transmission line.
