gas plant with cost-saving renewables**



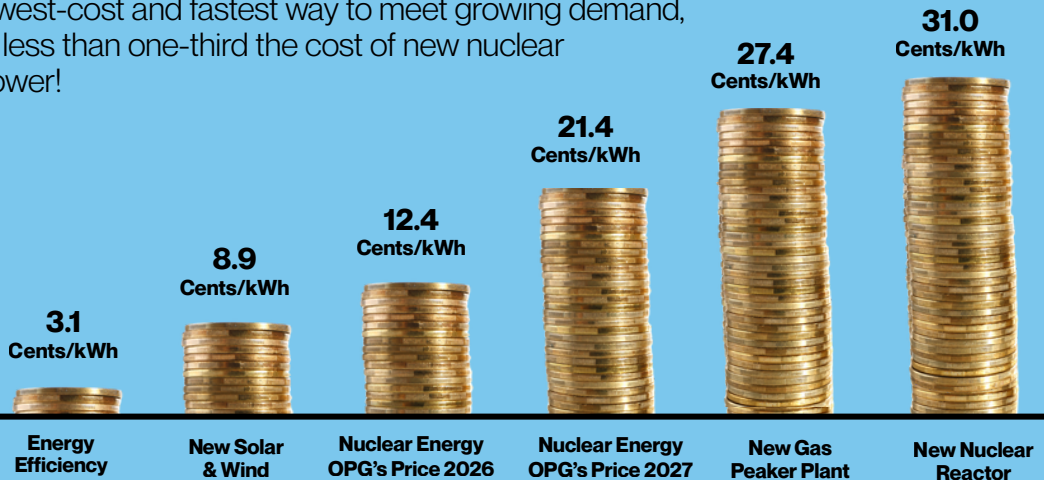
NUCLEAR & GAS: HIGHER BILLS, MORE POLLUTION

The Ford government wants Toronto to rely on the most expensive and polluting electricity options available: new nuclear reactors and increased output from the Portlands gas plant on Toronto's waterfront.

THE PRICE?

- **Higher electricity bills**
- **More toxic air pollution**
- **More dependence on U.S. energy imports**
- **Increased climate emissions**

Meanwhile, new wind and solar power are now the lowest-cost and fastest way to meet growing demand, at less than one-third the cost of new nuclear power!



RENEWABLES: THE BETTER PATH FOR TORONTO

WIND A Lake Ontario offshore wind farm could generate as much electricity as the Portlands gas plant, & at 10-15 km offshore would be almost invisible from land.

SOLAR Rooftop and parking lot solar could supply more than half of Toronto's electricity needs.

STORAGE Battery storage—including EV batteries—can deliver reliable electricity when demand is highest.

LOWER BILLS. ENERGY SECURITY. CLEANER AIR.

It's time for the City of Toronto and Toronto Hydro to expand rooftop & parking lot solar and battery storage, and ask the province to rescind its moratorium on offshore wind power.
