The Green Party of Canada does not support nuclear power because it is neither safe, nor clean, nor economical. Green Party MPs will work with provinces to phase out existing nuclear power, to stem the buildup of nuclear wastes, and to institute a Canada-wide moratorium on uranium mining and refining. We will end all subsidies and supports to the nuclear industry except those required to maintain the safety of existing facilities, and assist in phasing out and decommissioning facilities and sequestering associated radioactive wastes. We also call for the federal government to stop subsidizing all phases of the nuclear industry and Atomic Energy of Canada and stop promoting CANDU reactors. Instead of nuclear power, Greens will focus on increasing energy efficiency and supporting a full portfolio of renewable energy options including wind, solar and tidal.
